

The Toluca City Council met in regular meeting on July 13, 2026, with Mayor Zilm presiding. The following aldermen were present: Richard, Vallazza, Perry, Middleton, Schwanke. Absent: Miller.

The minutes were read and approved on a motion by Vallazza seconded by Richard. All aye. Motion carried. The current bills were reviewed and approved on a motion by Middleton seconded by Vallazza. All aye. Motion carried. The treasurer's report was reviewed and approved on a motion by Richard seconded by Perry. All aye. Motion carried. The city had excess flow for June.

A motion to pass the appropriations ordinance for \$4,182,900 was made by Vallazza seconded by Richard. All aye. Motion carried. A thank you was read from Janet Piasse and family for the military flag recognizing Steve Piasse. A thank you was read from the Toluca Labor Day committee for our partnership. A request from Carissa and Shane Fandel to have access to their building over Labor Day weekend was requested. The city will make small access to this building.

Trent Monge with Iron Horse presented his use of hay production for his animals on his properties in the subdivision. He stated this qualifies for agricultural use. The weeds are a problem and the height due to long rainy season. The council will table this and consult the zoning board.

Kim Bird with Hopkins and Assoc. presented the audit review for the Annual Financial Report for year ending April 30, 2026. A motion was made by Vallazza seconded by Richard to accept the report. All aye. Motion carried. The city will roll over the current General Fund Cd that is due for 12 more months. A motion was made by Vallazza seconded by Middleton to purchase a new Bob Cat for \$41,508.00 out of general fund. All aye. Motion carried. Sales tax was up for March 2026 compared to last year. A motion by Middleton seconded by Vallazza to purchase a new siren replacing the old one near the school for \$29,751.00. All aye. Motion carried. The city will work on sidewalks and replace the ramp to the Bowling Alley after Labor Day. The council signed a TIF district conflict of interest declaration form for Tim Schwanke. A motion by Vallazza seconded by Richard to pass the business revitalization grant for Michael Gerardo. Aye: Richard, Vallazza, Perry, Mayor Zilm. Abstain: Schwanke and Middleton. Absent: Miller.

The council members gave Sandy a list of properties that need mowed or issues to be sent a letter. Toni Wudtke let the council know the carnival will be good with cameras and officers available for coverage would be sufficient. They don't need 24-hour coverage.

A motion was made by Richard seconded by Vallazza to adjourn the meeting. All aye. Meeting closed.
